

## HELPFUL TIPS FOR NEUROPSYCHOLOGICAL PRACTICE BY DR. LARRY KUBIAK

1. Use the most current, useful and best normed tests available.
2. Utilize a battery of tests that best answers the referral question.
3. Get as much clarity of the referral question as possible.
4. Consider the possibility of malingering.
5. Consider psychological deficits along with or in place of neuropsychological deficits.
6. Belong to appropriate professional groups (i.e., neuropsychological division of FPA, NAN, APA Division 40, etc.).
7. Know your limits and when to refer. Seek supervision when needed.
8. Stay current with the literature (i.e., Archives of Clinical Neuropsychology, Neuropsychology Abstracts, etc.)
