


Adults reporting symptoms of Anxiety or Depression







Adults reporting Depression and Anxiety in the US and Florida





Adults reporting Depression and Anxiety by age



Dear Commissioners:

On behalf of the American Psychological Association and its companion organization APA Services, Inc. (APA/APASI)¹, I am writing to convey our concerns about the perils and unintended consequences to the public, especially vulnerable populations like children and adolescents, resulting from the underregulated development and deceptive deployment of generative AI or enabled technologies.



Randomized trial of a generative Al chatbot for mental health treatment NEJM (3/27/2025)

Randomized Clinical Trial (RCT)

N = 210 (assigned to Tx group or Cntrl group)

Tx = Therabot intervention

Cntrl= waitlist control (no tx)

Measured=symptom change at 4 & 8 weeks

Also measured therapeutic alliance



Florida Population Diversity for Psychologists




Workforce growth from 2022 to 2037





Value-Based Compensation Model

- Ties payment to quality of care
- Focus is on outcomes

- Incentivizes providers to focus on
 - Quality
 - Efficiency
 - Patient satisfaction
- Moves away from a fee-for-service model

Measurement-Based Care (MBC)

- Considered to be Evidence-Based practice using brief

assessment measures

The psychologist can:

- Monitor treatment progress
- Track symptom presentation with data
- Track the therapeutic relationship
- Use data to inform treatment planning & interventions
- Course-correct when data indicates it is necessary

Independent Practice Association (IPA)

- Network of psychologists in independent practice
- Power of negotiation with 3rd party payers
- Contracts with 3rd party payers as a group
- Streamline administrative processes
- Coordinates care with clinical integration

Benefits of an IPA

- Maintain independent business entity
- Enhanced negotiating power
- Reduced overhead and cost sharing
- Access to advanced technologies
- Access to data analytics for Measurement-Based Care

Clinical integration in an IPA model

- Shared protocols and standards

- Integrated health record systems

- Care coordination services

- Outcomes measured and tracked

Management Services Organization (MSO)

- Administrative support
- Financial Management
- IT services
- Compliance and regulatory support
- Marketing

Benefits of an MSO

In addition to the benefits of an IPA...

- Provides back-office services (billing, coding, payroll, office management)
- Streamlines administrative processes
- May include additional business services
 - Financial management
 - IT support
 - Practice operations

Mergers

- Forming larger group practices

- Integrating systems

- Maintaining ownership control

- Division of labor on business aspects
